HEAVENLY FATHER, I'M HAUNGRY

When Lori and I were on summer break from Asbury Theological Seminary, my sisters son came to spend a few weeks with us. He was 5 or 6 at the time and we had a wonderful time. The things I remember are: 1) his constant singing of the Ray Steven's song "Fred" and 2) the constant rumbling of his stomach. Lori and I couldn't fill the boy up. We'd get up from the table, go for a drive in the car, and I'd hear this soft little voice from the backseat, "Uncle Tucker, I'm haungry!"

I find myself constantly hungry these days. No, not physically hungry (although I really shouldn't have skipped breakfast this morning). There is a constant hunger in my spirit. Like Paul, I find "I press on" and "I strain forward"; I too want to "know Christ" in a deeper, more intimate way. I want to be filled with the fullness of Christ, to have that lingering emptiness and the rumblings of my soul, quenched!

One day, after He had fed the 5000 with five loaves and two fish, the crowd chased Jesus down. They followed Him and caught up with Him and He knew why: their bellies were growling. They didn't want Him; they wanted bread. But He surprised them; He said: "I am the Bread of Life."

It seems to me that all too often we get distracted by our physical needs and desires (the physical bread) and never get around to the Spiritual Bread. Many times, instead of feasting in Christ, we nibble. Yet let us remember, Jesus said: "Blessed are those hunger and thirst for righteousness for they shall be filled!"

Come Sunday, and let's talk about it!
