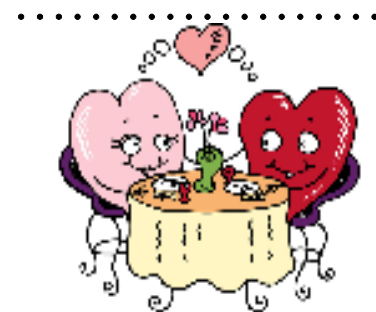

FISHING TECHNIQUES

Granddaddy could do it; Daddy could too, but not me! I'm often told that fishing would have a calming effect on me. You know, get out there in nature; watch the water drifting by; hear the birds singing; and watch the cork float. They suggest these things would bring me peace. ... NOT! This would absolutely drive me nuts. I don't even know where to begin fishing. The last time I went fishing with daddy (about 10 years ago), he still had to tell me, "You're not fishing deep enough."

Those who fish have found many similarities between fishing and evangelizing. After all, Jesus did tell the brothers, "Follow me and I will make you fishers of men." But sometimes, we just don't fish deep enough. Like the disciples, we busy ourselves, tirelessly working the shallows, getting a nibble here and a tug there, when the real catch is further out in the deep places. And so, our Master bids us, "Launch out into the deep."
