THE TRINITY: Bring Your Bucket

The contribution of Saint Augustine to modern Christian thought is unmistakable, but even this great theologian was sometimes baffled. When it came to understanding and communicating the doctrine of the Trinity, this was especially true. Around this time, he went for a walk along the beach and there, he saw a young boy with a bucket, running from the shoreline to a hole in the sand and back to the shoreline for more water. Augustine asked: "What are you doing?" And the boy replied: "I'm trying to put the ocean into this hole."

That's how I feel sometimes. The great things of God often seem just beyond my reach. They are so close that I can see them. I observe them. I even study them and yet, I cannot seem to grasp them, to fully know them.

In 1826, Reginald Heber penned a poem of praise to the Trinity; it reads: "Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty ... God in three persons, blessed Trinity!" Yet, even though we sing it, we do not fully comprehend it or appreciate the depth of who God is. This Sunday, Trinity Sunday, offers us an opportunity to reflect on the nature of God – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Will I see you in God's House?

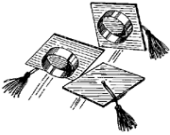
