THE SADDEST FUNERAL I EVER PREACHED

Jim was just a good ole boy, the envy of the community. He married his high school sweetheart, a gorgeous woman, inside and out. They had two children; both were high achievers in school and very visible in the community. They lived in the largest, most beautiful home in the community and drove the nicest cars. He was so driven to succeed, to beat out the competition, to own the nicest things, to provide for his family a "better life" than he had, to belong to the local club where he could entertain business contacts, that he missed everything else. He missed the warmth of a lovely wife, the joy of two great kids, and the spiritual enrichment of a church family. Jim had "big barns," but a very empty soul.
