WHERE IS YOUR HEART?

On the first day of school, the teacher sat her kindergarten class in a circle in the center of the room. Then, she asked them: "Girls and Boys, can anyone tell me where your heart is?" Little Billy started bouncing up and down, waving one hand furiously and patting the seat of his pants with the other. He said: "I know. I know. It is right back here." The teacher was curious; she said: "Billy, why do you say your heart is back there?" He said: "Well, grandma always pats me back there and says, 'Well, bless your little heart.'"

Where is your heart? When Charlotte was born, the nurse gave her to me and told me to follow her down to the nursery. I looked down into the face of an angel with tears flowing down my face and the nurse said: "Daddy, how does it feel to see your heart outside of your chest?"

Where is your heart? In Luke 12, Jesus makes it clear that you can find your heart by locating your treasure. Now, what exactly is treasure? Treasure is the things we identify as vitally important. For example, time is a treasure; money is a treasure; our talents or skills are treasures. So, if you want to locate your heart, you might ask: "Where do I spend my money?" Or "Where do I spend my time?" Or "Where do I use my talents and skills?"

For most of us, the church isn't that place. Far too often, we invest our "treasure" in the temporal things of life instead of the eternal. Yet, Jesus would ask us: Where is your Heart?
