WHERE ARE YOU SOWING?

It would be an interesting exercise for each of us if we drew a schematic of our circles of influence. Try it! Take a blank sheet of paper; draw a circle in the center and write your name inside of it. Then, think of all the places and people you encounter during a typical week. For example, some of us visit the Rec. fields; others, our places of work; others, the Bridge Club; and others, the local grocery store. Come on! Draw a circle for each of the places you visit during a typical week. Now, try to imagine: in each of these places, there are many people with whom you come into contact. How are you impacting their lives? How are you being an influence on them? Have you invited them to church?

The Gospels record a story Jesus told called "The Parable of the Sower." In it, a sower goes forth sowing seed and the seed fell upon four types of ground: the pathway, the rocky ground, the thorny ground, and the good ground. And of course, each of the types of soil responded to the seed in a unique way. One, the seed that fell upon the good soil, produced an abundant harvest.

Although the parable is clearly about the ways people responded to the ministry of Jesus, it also tells us of our responsibilities as sowers of the Word of God. This Sunday, we will explore the Parable of the Sower to discover anew the influence we might possibly have as we interact with our circles of influence.
